- 1. Registering your class for the WTBX's Book Worm Program is easy! Just call Linda before March 14, 2014, at WTBX and she will sign up your class. 749-3000, 262-4545 or 327-1194
- 2. Any Northland school teacher is welcome to register their class in the $1^{st} 6^{th}$ grade.
- 3. The reading contest will start on March 17th and end on April 18th, 2014.
- 4. The contest will be divided up into three groups: $1^{st}-2^{nd}$, $3^{rd}-4^{th}$ grade and $5^{th}-6^{th}$ grade.
- 5. All classrooms who sign up will receive two books for their classroom library from the United Way of Northeastern Minnesota. And all kids in our three winning classrooms will each receive a book also from the United Way of Northeastern Minnesota.
- 6. For students that apply books can be read to them, for those students who can read they must read the books themselves.
- 7. Each book completed must be registered on an official "WTBX Book Worm Log" form and verified by a parent/guardian or a teacher/school official. Feel free to make as many copies as needed. The classroom teacher must collect and total all forms.
- 8. The total of all books completed by your class, and all the "WTBX Book Worm Log" forms must be returned to WTBX by Friday April 25th, 2014. The winning classrooms will be announced LIVE on the WTBX morning show the following week. WTBX will coordinate the day and time for the class's pizza party with the teacher after the winning classes are announced.
- 9. The classes, one from each group, that have read the most books during the contest will win a pizza party with Craig and Rachel from WTBX and Sammy's Pizza!
