Galloway Campaign Statement on Representative Donna Seidel's Campaign Announcement

The Galloway Campaign released the following statement regarding Representative Donna Seidel's recall candidacy announcement:

"Senator Galloway's record stands for itself and she did the job she was elected to do by the people of the 29th Senate District. Senator Galloway will not bend to the greedy Madison special interests and public sector union bosses who are behind this recall effort. It is Donna Seidel's inability to say no to these left wing special interest groups that nearly drove Wisconsin off an economic cliff.

"The last time Senator Galloway's opponent was in charge of our state budget, Wisconsin was left with a \$3.6 billion deficit, which amounted to nearly \$640 owed for every man, woman and child in Wisconsin. It was Donna Seidel's 2009 budget that increased taxes by billions of dollars on the working families and job creators of our state. The Seidel-Doyle budget also included changes that led to huge rate increases for auto insurance, inflated the costs for seniors in nursing homes, and stuck the taxpayers with millions of dollars in unpaid bills to various segregated funds.
