

RECOUNT PETITION

In Re: The Election for
21st Senate District

Verified Petition
for Recount

Petitioner Van H. Wanggaard alleges and shows to Wisconsin's Government Accountability Board:

1. That Petitioner was a candidate for the office of State Senate, 21st District in an election held on June 5, 2012;
2. That Petitioner is informed and believes that a mistake has been committed in 21st Senate District (all in the counting and return of votes cast for the office of state senator; and
3. That Petitioner is informed and believes that:
 - a. Numerous challenges by election observers were not properly documented or acknowledged by election officials;
 - b. Individuals providing assistance to voters were not properly documented;
 - c. Individuals were allowed to register to vote and vote with improper proof of residence and/or identification;
 - d. Individuals were electioneering in polling locations;
 - e. Individuals voted in more than one location;
 - f. Individuals were given incentives to vote.

Wherefore: Petitioner requests a recount of the entire 21st Senate District.
